EduWeb has now been available for one year. Some schools have been using it from the beginning. Some have only just started to use it. Many are not using it at all.

Twelve months ago, a utility called **EduWeb** was developed to introduce the concept of student-centred intranets to all schools in NSW. To launch the utility, an information session was held at Oatley Senior High School, attended by about 150 teachers.
